## Jesus is better! Hebrews 11:1-3

## FOLLOWING THE MESSAGE

- 1) Salvation is a gift of God, and part of that gift is faith itself.
- 2) Three stages to faith that God honors:
  - Felt Need—Felt need does not require theological understanding of the doctrine of salvation, only a sincere heart that knows it needs salvation.
  - Content—A person does not have to comprehend the full knowledge of the doctrine of salvation before he can be saved, but he does need the gospel truth (1 Corinthians 15:1–5) that he is lost in sin and needs Jesus as Savior.
  - Commitment—A believer must totally commit his life to the Lord Jesus.
- 3) 11:1 If faith is a gift from God, then it is God's way of giving me confidence that what He promised will be accomplished.
- 4) 11:1 True Biblical faith is confident submission to God's Word in spite of circumstances, not in spite of evidence.
- 5) 11:1 The promises given to the Old Testament saints were so real to them that they based their lives on them. They took God at His word.
- 6) 11:1 Their faith in things yet unseen gave present assurance to what was yet future.
- 7) 11:2 Faith is not simply one way among many to please God; it is the only way!
- 8) 11:3 The visible universe is not sufficient to account for itself. It is faith (not something material) that assures us it originated with God.

9) 11:3 A great deal of what our God has done and is doing is only grasped by faith.
