

**I Need a Hero—Part 2** **October 4/5, 2014**  
**Exodus 3/Hebrews 11:24-27**  
**Moses**

**FOLLOWING THE MESSAGE**

- 1) Had Moses grown up with his fellow Hebrews, he would not have developed the confidence, vision, and courage to lead a great people.
- 2) *3:2* Miracles are not sideshows to entertain; they accredit the Word of God.
- 3) *3:5* Because God was present, what had been ordinary became holy (set apart for a purpose).
- 4) *3:5* God's Spirit within you because of your faith in Jesus is what makes you holy. God declares you holy because He is with you, not because of something you have done.
- 5) *3:6* The God who sees, hears, and knows His people is also the God who saves.
- 6) *3:7* God can and does follow the stream of human events and does intervene in human affairs.
- 7) *3:8-9* Israel had a need. God had the solution.
- 8) *3:10* What Moses considered himself qualified for 40 years earlier was the same thing he no longer thought himself capable of doing.
- 9) *3:12* The Exodus did not depend on the competence of Moses, but on the presence of God.
- 10) *3:12* The sign would not be confirmed until Moses led God's people out of Egypt and back to the mountain. The success of his mission *was* the sign.
- 11) *3:13* Moses was worried that people would ask hard questions that he could not answer. He was focused on his own capacity, rather than on God's.

12) *3:14* "I AM" expresses the nature, the character, and the essence of "I will be with you" (3:12).

13) *3:19* God knew exactly what the king's reactions would be. Moses was warned to not misconstrue any rejection as a sign God was not with him.

14) *3:20* The God who saves is also the God who knows the future.
