Romans 4:22-25

FOLLOWING THE MESSAGE

- 1) 4:22 God makes a commitment to us when we believe: He credits righteousness to us.
- 2) 4:23 Events that happened in the past, in an age that we did not see, have an impact on how we live in this day; they were written for our instruction and to give hope and direction (Romans 15:4).
- 3) 4:24 Paul applies the word “our” to a specific people group; it is not to just anybody, but to “those who believe.”
- 4) 4:24 The resurrection is the proof that God the Father accepted the sacrifice of God the Son.
- 5) 4:24 Faith is the condition for salvation.
- 6) 4:25 Believers are justified now and sealed by the Holy Spirit, but the consummation of it waits until Judgment Day.
- 7) 4:25 Without Jesus’ death, there would be no basis for acquittal. Without His resurrection, there would be no proof of the redemption.
- 8) 4:25 Jesus was delivered to death for our transgression. Jesus was delivered from death for our justification.
