1. Faith is believing what God has revealed.
2. God is a true communicator; He desires that we know.
3. 6:5 The cause for the Flood is tied directly to the fall of man in chapter 3.
4. 6:6 This verse is not suggesting that God made a mistake and therefore regrets His actions (Malachi 3:6; Isaiah 46:9-10).
5. 6:6 God does feel deep emotion and grieves when mankind chooses what is evil.
6. 6:8 Noah was not better than everyone else; he simply believed God when others refused. He lived a life of obedience.
7. 6:22 There was no negotiating or complaining on Noah's part. Scripture says he did exactly what he was supposed to do.
8. 6:22 Noah followed God commands; in so doing, he found salvation in the covenant God made with him.
9. 7:16 Those who live are those who enter the one ark, doing as God commanded. Obedience to God's way is the way to life.
10. God's heart is continually toward restoration, yet man refuses to trust Him.
11. 12:4 Through Abraham's obedience, Israel became an analogy of God's redemption.
12. Abraham is called the "father of faith," but his circumstances did not always cause him to feel like he was being blessed.
13. Walking by faith means placing our trust in the truth of what God declares, rather than merely trusting our senses.
