1. Everything that exists is for the glory of God!
2. 16:25 The action of God, personified in man's history on earth, is done so in order that we will be directed towards our true purpose and perfect end.
3. 16:25 God does not secure His strength by keeping His people weak; He is magnified by making his people strong.
4. 16:25 God makes you stronger with the truth of the Gospel.
5. 16:25 That which establishes is the truth that Jesus is the risen Lord and soon-coming King.
6. 16:25 In the New Testament, a mystery refers to something hidden in former times but now made known.
7. 16:25 God may choose to make Himself known, but that does not mean that everything about Him has been revealed (1 Peter 1:12).
8. 16:25 Three aspects of this mystery:
 - The gospel is something people could never have worked out for themselves.
 - The Son of God would come from Heaven to live among us and die for us so that we could enter into salvation by faith.
 - The Jew and the Gentiles would be united as believers in one body, the Church.
9. 16:26 What had been predicted in veiled words by the Scriptures of the prophets has been made clear.
10. 16:26 When faith in Jesus produces obedience to Jesus, those obedient lives bring glory to God.
11. 16:26 The purpose of the mystery is now revealed: to bring all nations to the obedience of faith (Romans 1:5).
