

Jesus is better!
Hebrews 6:10-20

FOLLOWING THE MESSAGE

- 1) *6:10* God will not forget what we have done in His name.
- 2) *6:10* Love of any kind is regarded only as pretense if not exerted in such a way as to display a reality by a matching action.
- 3) *6:10* Without loving God first and foremost, we are not able to love each other completely.
- 4) *6:10* Our works are not what saved us or keep us saved, but they are an evidence of our salvation (James 2:18, 26).
- 5) *6:10* Only God's love has this kind of staying power.
- 6) *6:11* No movement has ever gripped the hearts of people if it does not give them hope.
- 7) *6:11* Biblical definition of "hope" is that which has not yet been realized, but is certain/sure.
- 8) *6:12* The imitation is not to be of their personalities or abilities or individual lifestyles or habits, but of their faith.
- 9) *6:13* Though Abraham had God's promise, he *only* had God's promise. He lived many years in expectation, with nothing to go on except God's commitment.
- 10) *6:13-20* God's promises are secured by four rock solid truths:
 1. His Person (6:13)—God is Truth. If God makes a promise, He not only will keep it...He must keep it!
 2. His Purpose (6:14)—God's promise guaranteed its own fulfillment because it was His idea, His purpose, His plan.
 3. His Pledge (6:16)—Not only is it impossible for God to lie, but His Word of Truth is supported by His oath.
 4. His Priest (6:19-20)—We have but one anchor, Jesus Christ, our solid Hope (Colossians 1:5, 1 Timothy 1:1).

Nōthros (no-thros')—sluggish, (literal) lazy, or (figurative) stupid :- slothful
 Plērophoria (play-rof-or-ee'-ah)—entire confidence :- (full) assurance
 Prodromos—forerunner
