

## ROMANS—Part 84

Romans 14:10-13

1. 14:10 All believers will be judged by God for our actions (not our sins).
2. 14:10 The fact that our sins will never be brought against us should **not** move us toward disobedience.
3. 14:10 Because Jesus is Lord, each believer will stand because of and before Jesus, first as Savior then as Judge. How does a Christian prepare for the judgment seat of Christ?
  - Make Jesus the Lord of your life.
  - Faithfully obey Him.
  - Judge your own life, instead of the lives of others.
4. 14:10 What we do is the most accurate indicator of what we really believe.
5. 14:10 Salvation is by faith, but the evidence of faith is a transformed life which yields fruit in this life and rewards in the next.
6. 14:12 This judgment seat involves believers giving an accounting of their lives to Christ (2 Corinthians 5:10).
7. 14:12 The Bible speaks of the Judgment Seat of Christ (bema) in three places: Romans 14:10-12; 1 Corinthians 3-4; 2 Corinthians 5:1-10.
8. 14:12 Your rewards will be based on how faithfully you served Christ. It will be an examination of total life commitment, a summing up of the total pattern of your life.
9. 14:12 Sin and apathy rob us of the desire to serve the Lord. In turn, this means there will be a loss of rewards, because we will not have used our time to His glory.
10. 14:12 The great consequence of unfaithfulness is that it disappoints Christ (1 John 2:28).
