1. 15:4 Hope does not fade.
 2. 15:4 Biblical hope is guaranteed by God but has not yet occurred.
 3. 15:4 The Word of God not only reminds believers of our true eternal hope, but also tells everyone else that it is there for them.
 4. 15:4 Endurance and encouragement proceed forth from God and are not things that we can manufacture.
 5. 15:4 The Word of God is not just a source of technical information or a collection of stories for the sake of knowledge alone. It is God's chosen instrument to bring comfort, consolation, and patient endurance. It is also a catalyst for our lives.
 6. 15:5 These qualities are a gift from God and are not the result of human achievement.
 7. 15:5 Paul prayed that believers would literally "mind the same thing," which is more than just unanimity in and of itself.
 8. 15:5 Even the things that God demands of us He gives to us.
 9. 15:6 The consummate purpose of unity is not to please other believers, it is to please the Lord, inwardly and outwardly, individually and corporately.
 10. 15:6 When believers glorify God, the created takes up the appropriate position before the Creator.
 11. Whatever difficulty you face today is bearable because God, in his Word, tells us of a better time to come.
