1. “Doxology” comes from doxa (meaning glory) and logos (meaning word), so a doxology is words which ascribe glory to God.
2. A doxology is a biblical form of speaking rooted in the all-important and all-embracing truth that everything exists to draw attention to the glory of God
3. 16:25 God is able; He has abundant power to establish those who trust in Him according to the true gospel.
4. 16:25 Believers are established by truth to explain God’s plan of salvation so we would share the truth with those who are lost.
5. 16:25 Through the true gospel, God establishes the mind in truth; He grounds us and makes us firm in Him so that we are not driven about by the winds of deceitful doctrine.
6. 16:25 Paul spoke of the gospel that had been revealed to him—just like it has been revealed to you and countless millions around the globe—which he had made his own (Romans 2:16; 2 Timothy 2:8).
7. 16:25 The gospel is revealed truth, not human wisdom (Galatians 1:11-12).
8. 16:25 The only gospel that establishes is the gospel that proclaims Jesus (1 Corinthians 1:23; 2 Corinthians 4:5).
