## Rejecting God: A Nation Under Wrath

- 1. We cannot appreciate God's grace, love, & holiness until we see the consequence of sin. Because there is sin, there is wrath Wrath is God's active opposition to everything opposed to Him.
- If we accept that whatever God does is righteous, we must believe His wrath is also righteous. He cannot act unrighteously. (Romans 1:18)
- The 'Gospel' is necessary because there is a 'Wrath of God'. Only the Gospel of Jesus brings deliverance from His wrath. (Romans 1:16-17)
- 4. God cares for and loves us so much that He acts and reveals. He is actively doing something in opposition to sin.
- 5. Wrath from God's perspective:
  - Origin of the wrath It is of God. God's wrath is always righteous.
     Wrath is the only response a Holy God can have toward evil.
     (Habakkuk 1:13)
  - Timing of His wrath It is constantly being revealed. (Romans 8:20-22)
  - Extent of the wrath Against us all! We all have sin, it infests our world.
     (Romans 3:23, 1 John 1:8)
- 6. When a nation forsakes God, it loses its moral compass and loses its capacity to be outraged by sin. (Romans 1:18)
- 7. Humanity stands guilty under God's wrath because they sin against the truth they do have, not the truth they don't have.
  (Romans 1:19)
- 8. God giving a society over and letting them go to the uninterrupted cause and effect of sinful choices. This is the wrath of abandonment. (Romans 1:24, 26, 28)
- 9. No matter how little spiritual light a culture has, God guarantees any person who sincerely seeks will find. (Jeremiah 29:13)
- 10. The cross shows the full measure of God's wrath. Forgiveness is as costly as the cross, and it is meaningless without wrath. (John 1:36, Romans 5:8-9)
