And His father and mother were amazed at the things which were being said about Him. **Luke 2:33**

And when eight days had passed, before His circumcision, His name was called Jesus, the name given by the angel before He was conceived in the womb. **Luke 2:21**

And when the days for their purification according to the law of Moses were completed, they brought Him up to Jerusalem to present Him to the Lord (as it was written in the Law of the Lord, “Every firstborn male that opened the womb shall be called holy to the Lord”), and to offer a sacrifice according to what was said in the Law of the Lord, “A pair of turtledoves or two young pigeons.” **Luke 2:22-23**

...nevertheless the firstborn of man you shall surely redeem... As to their redemption price, from a month old you shall redeem them, by your valuation, five shekels in silver... **Numbers 18:15-16**

And there was a man in Jerusalem whose name was Simeon; and this man was righteous and devout, looking for the consolation of Israel; and the Holy Spirit was upon him. **Luke 2:25**

And it had been revealed to him by the Holy Spirit that he would not see death before he had seen the Lord’s Christ. And he came in the Spirit to the temple. **Luke 2:26-27**

...and when the parents brought in the child Jesus, to carry out for Him the custom of the Law, then he took Him into his arms, and blessed God. **Luke 2:27-28**

“And I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your offspring and hers; he will crush your head, and you will strike his heel. **Genesis 3:15**

Behold, a virgin will be with child and bear a son, and she will call His name Immanuel. **Isaiah 7:14**

But when the fullness of time had come, God sent forth His Son, born of a woman... **Galatians 4:4**

...as for you , Bethlehem Ephrathah, Too little to be among the clans of Judah, From you One will go forth for Me to be ruler in Israel. His goings forth are from long ago, from the days of eternity. **Micah 5:2**

Joseph also went up from Galilee, from the city of Nazareth to Judea, to the city of David which is called Bethlehem. **Luke 2:4**

The scepter shall not depart from Judah, Nor the ruler's staff from between his feet, Until Shiloh comes, and to him shall be the obedience of the peoples. **Genesis 49:10**

For it is evident that our Lord was descended from Judah... **Hebrews 7:14**

Thus says the Lord, "A voice is heard in Ramah, Lamentation and bitter weeping, Rachel is weeping for her children; She refuses to be comforted for her children, Because they are no more." **Jeremiah 31:15**

Then when Herod saw that he had been tricked by the magi, he became very enraged, and sent and slew all the male children who were in Bethlehem and all its vicinity, from two years old and under, according to the time which he had determined from the magi. **Matthew 2:16**

...but whenever a person turns to the Lord, the veil is taken away. **2 Corinthians 3:16**
