John 14:15-31

FOLLOWING THE MESSAGE

- 1) 14:15 There is an inseparable link between love and obedience (1 John 2:3–5).
- 2) The profession of affection for God is in vain if there is no evidence that we follow His commandments.
- 3) 14:16-17 The Holy Spirit is the perfect substitute for the Lord Jesus Christ. Like Jesus, the Holy Spirit would teach (John 14:26), strengthen (Ephesians 3:16), and intercede for the disciples (Romans 8:26).
- 4) 14:17 Unable to receive the Spirit, “the world” demonstrates its real character—opposed to the Father (1 John 2:16).
- 5) 14:17 In the Old Testament, the Spirit came on believers for special capacity, but He now indwells every believer permanently (Romans 8:9; 1 Corinthians 12:13).
- 6) 14:18 There is no need to have a troubled heart when you have the very Spirit of God dwelling within you!
- 7) 14:21 Obedience is not the cause of salvation, but rather the inevitable result.
- 8) 14:23 Jesus will not reveal Himself to those who refuse to obey Him.
- 9) 14:23 When Jesus left in order to prepare ‘dwelling-places’ for believers, He simultaneously joined the Father in making ‘dwelling-places’ *in* believers.
- 10) 14:24 Mere duty will not generate obedience to Christ; only love for Him can do that.
- 11) 14:25 Just as Jesus would not leave the disciples without a source of comfort, so also He would not leave them without a source of truth.
- 12) 14:26 A function of the Spirit is teaching. He instructs us from within and brings to the memory God’s Word.
- 13) Aware of the disciples’ distress, Jesus points them to the ultimate sure sources of hope...the promise of their future, the triune God & the Word of God.

GREEK WORDS

Paraklētos — Helper, an intercessor, consoler :- advocate (defense attorney), comforter, counselor, exhorter, encourager; literally “one called alongside to help”
Allos — Another of the same kind
Heteros — Another of a completely different nature
Emphanizo, *em-fan-id'-zo*; to *exhibit* (in person) or *disclose* (by words)
:- appear, declare (plainly), inform, (will) manifest
